




Market Commentary
Oil prices jumped again today as disruptions to the Caspian Pipeline
Consortium are adding concerns to the already tight global supplies.
Exports from CPCs Kazakhstan's terminal stopped fully today after
damage from bad weather, and the disruption could take weeks or
months to resolve. This pipeline carries 1.2MM/bpd or roughly 1.2% of
global supply. "There's a growing consensus that the de facto ban on
Russian oil purchases has resulted in a supply disruption of 2 to 3 million
barrels a day, and until the world can figure out how to replace that oil
we're going to march on higher until demand destruction takes place,"
said Andrew Lipow, president of Lipow Oil Associates in Houston. US crude
production remained flat at 11.6MM/bpd for the 7th straight week but
crude inventories fell another 2.5MM/bbls. WTI traded up \$5.66 or 5.18%
to close at \$114.93. Brent traded up \$6.12 or 5.3% to close at \$121.60.


